Emmet Street is a gateway to our city and the University of Virginia. It's a vital place and the first impression of our community for most/many out-of-town visitors. The purpose of this project is to redesign Emmet Street between Ivy Road/ University Avenue and Arlington Boulevard, transforming it into a complete street that safely accommodates all people, regardless of their abilities or means of travel.

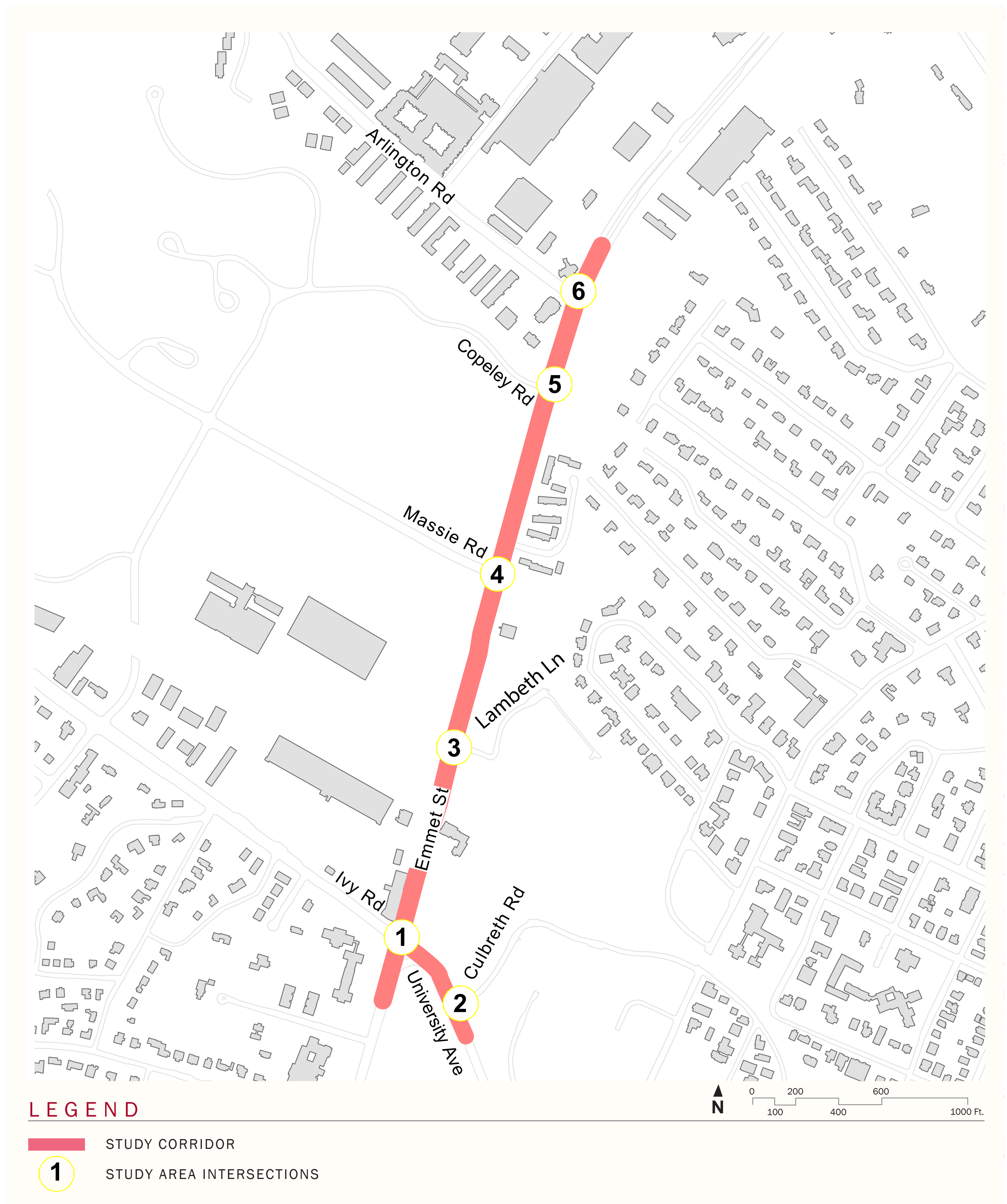
Project Description

The state awarded the City of Charlottesville with \$12 million in Smart Scale funding to design and construct improvements to Emmet Street including bicycle lanes, a shared-use path (including a path tunnel under the railroad), bus shelters and consolidated bus stops, new pedestrian signals, crossings, and landscaping.

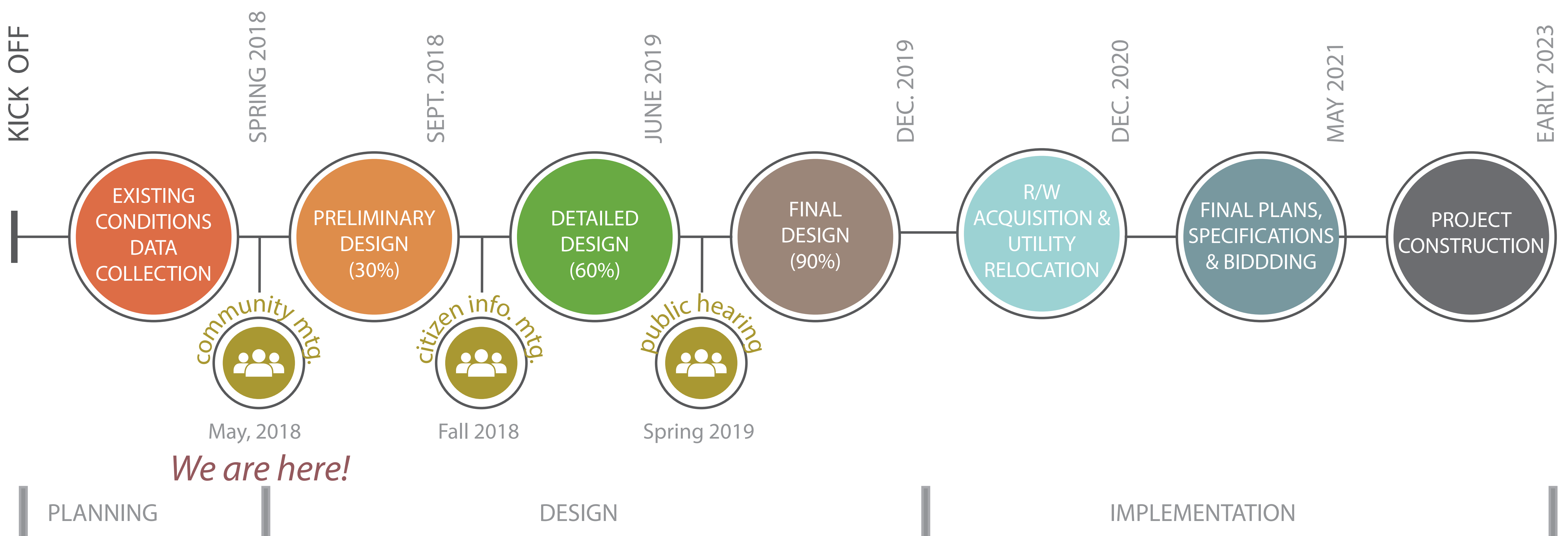
Meeting Purpose
